Mr. Hervé Magro assumed his role as Ambassador of France to Lebanon on 21 August 2023. With nearly forty years of active diplomatic service at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Hervé Magro has held various responsibilities within both the central administration and the diplomatic and consular network. A graduate of the National Institute for Oriental Languages and Civilizations (INALCO), he has been awarded the Legion of Honour as well as the National Order of Merit.
